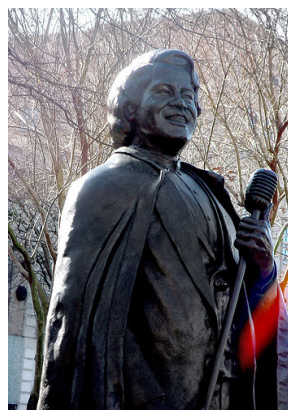

A life-size statue of James Brown stands at James Brown Plaza in Broad Street, at the north end of the Augusta Common between 8th and 9th street.

James Brown and his father moved to Augusta when he was 6 years old. He has been honored here for his philanthropy and civic activities. In 1993, Mayor Charles DeVaney dedicated a section of 9th Street between Broad and Twiggs Streets, renamed "James Brown Boulevard"

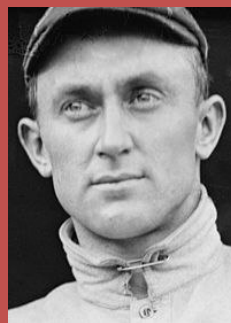
As a 72nd birthday present for Brown, the city of Augusta Brown was unveiled a life-sized James Brown statue on Broad Street -the We Feel Good Committee received approval to change Augusta's slogan to "We Feel Good". Afterwards, Official renamed the city's civic center the [James Brown Arena](#), and James Brown attended a ceremony for the unveiling of the [namesake](#) center on October 15, 2006.

APR 21ST TOM SUTHERLAND - INTERCLUB!

For nearly a quarter of a century, **Ty Cobb**, the greatest baseball player of his day - and some say of all time - made his home in Augusta. He finished his incredible career with dozens of records, including the highest lifetime batting average in major league history.

Cobb, known as the "Georgia Peach," was also one of the top celebrities of his day - a man who golfed with U.S. presidents, made a fortune on outside investments and even played the theater circuit.



Cobb's legacy as an athlete has sometimes been overshadowed by his surly temperament and aggressive playing style,

Cobb is widely credited with setting 90 Major League Baseball records during his career. He still holds several records as of 2009, including the highest career batting average (.367) and most career batting titles.

He remains a legend at the Green Jackets Stadium here in Augusta.
