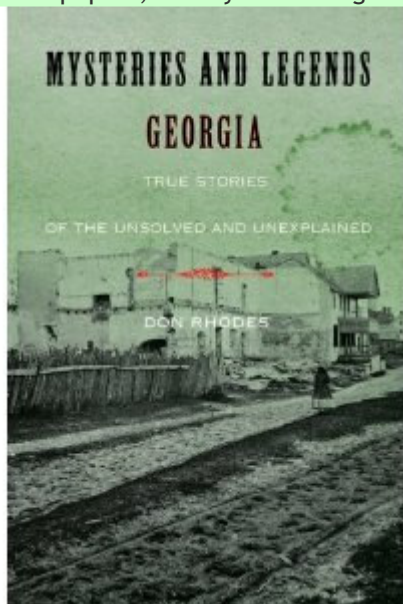
Kiwanis of Uptown Augusta
