ADP Security, Bass Pro Shops and CarMax are just a few companies expanding into Augusta and soon to be hiring.

New businesses like ADP, scheduled to be open in March, are set to bring in thousands of new jobs.

Richmond County Development Authority Director, Walter Sprouse, says he and others are working hard to get new businesses to move to Augusta everyday. Sprouse also says when the businesses arrive, they hire more local people.

"Teleperformance, another company that said they were going to hire 250 people. They didn't hire 250 people, they hired 320 instead. So we're seeing some good news like that," said Sprouse.

Despite being in an environment with companies cutting back and closing stores, Sprouse says Augusta has stood firm for the most part.

"Ironically here in Augusta, we've seen our project levels stay pretty steady. As a matter of fact, we've seen it increase."
