When you buy a Kindle (Kindle 2 or Kindle DX) you are buying into the Amazon Ecosystem. The concept of an e-book is not well understood by anyone -you can register up to six Kindles on one Amazon account with one credit card. This entitles you to share books between all of the Kindles on the account. Even though you can share books between Kindles on the same account, you cannot easily, wirelessly, share periodicals between them.
