This week we welcomed Dr. Cheryl Wheeler – Cancer Specialist at University Hospital – March is Colorectal Cancer Month –



March is colorectal cancer month. Familial adenomatous polyposis is one risk factor. Less than one percent risk.

Previous polyps, previous cancer also risks. Hereditary nonpolyposis colorectal cancer, risk 3-6 percent. Usually 5-10 years growth in polyps before malignancy.

Screening usually starts age 50. If parent had, start exams 10 years before age of parent when they had it.

Double contrast barium enema of colon if colonoscopy can't be done.

Fecal occult test cheap, but many false positives. Fecal immunochemical test more accurate, but still need more tests if positive.

Colonoscopy more expensive but averages out, sees whole bowel.

In 2009 University's Cancer Program received a three-year approval with commendation and the Outstanding Achievement Award from the Commission on Cancer of the American College of Surgeons. University is the only hospital in Georgia and one of only 95 in the country to receive this honor. The Commission on Cancer established the outstanding Achievement Award in 2004 to recognize cancer programs that strive for excellence in providing quality care to cancer patients. A facility receives the award following the on-site evaluation by a physician surveyor during which the facility must demonstrate a commendation level of compliance with seven standards that represent the full scope of the cancer program. In addition, the facility must receive a compliance rating for the remaining 29 cancer program standards (cancer committee leadership, cancer data management, clinical services, research, community outreach and quality improvement).

Established in 1922 by the American College of Surgeons, the Commission on Cancer is a consortium of professional organizations dedicated to improving survival rates and quality of life for cancer patients through standard-setting, prevention, research, education and the monitoring of comprehensive, quality care. Its membership includes Fellows of the American College of Surgeons and 40 national organizations that reflect the full spectrum of cancer care.
