Now that we have attracted great new members please reach out to them to participate on committees – we are in desperate need to build an active Youth Services Committee – what better job is there?

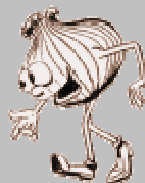

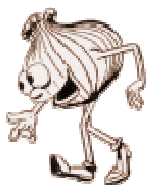
